*Sherwood did not have its unique zip code of 72120 until 1995. Prior to 1995, parts of Sherwood shared the 72116 zip code with North Little Rock. It took over 20 years and 4 mayors with countless letters and phone calls to secure the 72120 zip for the whole city of Sherwood.
